

Goliath Mats Shipping Guide

Our Goliath mats are shipped on a full size tractor trailer. The driver will not be able to offload these long heavy pallets. You will need to have the proper equipment on site at the time of delivery to remove the pallets from the truck yourself.

What you'll need

1. Forklift or tractor
2. Chain, heavy strap or heavy rope

Method 1 – Truck with Liftgate



1. Wrap chain, strap or rope around the end of the skid and securely tie off to the tractor forks or bucket.



2. Pull skid back and bring up tailgate.



3. If there's room, pull the skid off the truck to where the end of the skid is resting on the liftgate. Otherwise, the driver can drive the truck slowly forward until the end of the skid is on the liftgate.



4. Slowly lower the skid to the ground.

Method 2 – Truck without Liftgate



1. Wrap chain, strap or rope around the end of the skid and securely tie off to the tractor forks or bucket.



2. If there's room, pull the skid off the truck to where the end of the skid is resting just before the end of the truck. Otherwise, the driver can drive the truck slowly forward until the end of the skid is at the back of the truck. Be sure to leave at least about 1-2 ft of the skid on the truck.

3. Very slowly lower the skid to the ground making sure the opposite end doesn't slide off the truck



4. Very carefully wrap chain, strap or rope around the other end of the skid that is on the truck and securely tie off to the tractor forks or bucket.

5. Slowly lift the skid off the truck and have the driver pull away.

6. Slowly lower the skid to the ground.

Other Notes

This product is delivered by a 3rd party trucking company on a full sized tractor trailer. Depending on conditions on site such as trees, driveway width, road width, soft ground, the truck may not be able to get into your driveway to drop off the shipment. In this case, the product would have to be delivered at the edge of your driveway by the road.
